

**Project Update: October 2007**

They have been implementing all the activities from the permission of Department of National Parks and Wildlife Reserves under the Ministry of Forest and Soil Conservation of Government of Nepal. Formally they received permission letter in first week of February. Therefore, informally they started the program from mid-August, 2006 and formally Bishnu in February, 2007 because they got permission letter on the first week of February.

CCAP have been proposed as technical partner of Gharial Conservation in Nepal, a long term project for sustainable conservation of Gharial (*Gavialis gangeticus*) in Nepal to implement its next 4 years' activities.
