

Project Update: February 2009

26 species of medium and large mammals have been registered in the study area, until this moment the project has confirmed 61% of these species, of which 43% are carnivores, which are species that must be preserved. *Dasypus hybridus* has been registered which is a species with priority for conservation in the study area. Exotic species have also been registered such as *Sus scrofa*, *Lepus europaeus* and *Capra hircus*. Meetings with landowners from within and around the area were held, with the objective of knowing more about species present in the area as well as concerns they have with boars (*Sus scrofa*).
