

Project Update: January 2012

We had some great results on the project. One of them being that we confirmed the existence of a new cryptic subspecies of karst viper in Bosnia and Herzegovina. We managed to prepare and print the leaflets for educational purposes in Bosnia and Herzegovina and we have held one lecture in Sarajevo University as guests of Professor Suvad Lelo who offered all of his help and also co-authored in the leaflet preparation (because of the specific Bosnian language).

In the addition to this project we have great cooperation with the city Zoo in Zagreb and Sarajevo and we made a small educational exhibition called "Our three Vipers" (first news in the web) and had more than 60 000 visitors, mainly children (we had a special school programme for education about snakes).
