

Project Update: September 2012

An environmental education session for 43 young students from 5 to 14 years (Burundi tomorrow as we say here) living close to the forest was organised around the theme: "The role of the natural forest of Bururi and its biological richness."

The session was organised in two stages:

1. The children were closely followed a documentary video on the rich flora and fauna of the natural forest reserve of Bururi as important ecotourism potential.
2. A ballad of these children was held in the reserve to observe and follow the explanations on the use of socio-economic species of flora and fauna of the forest. After, an occasion has given to the children to ask questions of understanding to the facilitators of this session and satisfactory answers were given. The session was closed by engagement of children to be the ambassadors of this forest. The joy of children was so great that most of them put their foot for the first time in the office of the reserve since they were born.
