

Project Update: November 2014

This picture is of a huge poster the Green Fins Vietnam team have put on their port in Nha Trang, Vietnam. This port is a hub for diving and snorkelling boats to depart for the local MPA sites. Nha Trang is a mass diving destination, with about 20 dive centres often taking up to 100 divers out each day during the high season. The snorkel centres and number of guests is completely unknown, giving an idea of how unmanaged this industry is. This poster is very visible in the port and is getting a lot of attention.

The Rufford logo has remained on the soft copy of the files we pass out to project partners as a reflection of the incredible support Rufford have shown to us over the years. As a result you will see it here on this poster! Even though the Rufford funds were not used to directly implement activities in Vietnam, this support has enabled us to be more sustainable as an organisation and as a result our conservation impact through Green Fins has reach out to a very wide audience internationally.
