Project Update: June 2013

After the location definition and opening of transects we started the line transect sampling. We walked 252km that made possible 30 registrations of southern muriquis groups in study area.

In June 2013, we did a pilot interview in order to standardise the methodology and permit the beginning of informers selection in neighborhoods surrounding the study area (through 'snowball' method), to characterise hunting activity and acquire more information about the profile of hunters.
