

## **Project Update: May 2014**

The Yalahau Lagoons State Park was visited for four months (January – April). A total 53 species have been recorded until now, belonging to eight families; all are new records to the park. For each species we have taken record about the type of vegetation where it was capture. Until this moment we have photographed 32 species which will be include on a catalogue.

During this period we could recognize more than three types of vegetation. Near to lagoons we observed tulares and floodplain forest as more we went far away of water deposits, change to the deciduous dry forest. However it is subdivided in three, mature forest with more than 80 years of conservation, transitional vegetation with less than 30 years and disturbed forest which include crops and silvopastoral lands.
