

## Project Update: June 2015

From May to June 2015, the work of the project was very intense, and paying attention that was corresponded with the final period. A great communal mobilisation took effect and people have laboured so much at his particular lots and at the community's surroundings, like in the natural areas of the National Park, this way was possible to manage directly at 15 ha of degraded lots. The communities, guided for specialists, will utilise practical methods to preserve soil from erosion, like barriers to soil retention, plantation of lively coverage, coverage with natural and artificial blankets, drainage and deviation ditches. The educational work also was intense: we distributed brochures and pliable, two geographic excursions with children were executed, and three with tourists, the projection of a video about the works obeyed in the areas and farmsteads were accomplished and a final workshop developed days 18 and June 19 to interchange experiences and to evaluate the results of the project.
