

Project Update: September 2014

The works of the project initiated since July to September 2014. The four journeys to travel the degraded areas and to characterise physical-biological environment were very important.

We chose the principal places to make works:



Left: Jiguaní- Jaragua locality: It extends throughout 18 ha, located from the margin east of the river Jiguaní, to a height of 200 m and comprising 4 km parallel to the Baracoa road. Right: Poligono locality: 4 ha surface, with bare ground, at slope of 18 degrees.



Left: Cantera locality: have three with presence of places with landslides, ditches and linear erosion. Right: Low basin of Taco River (El Recreo): have 10 ha with not much protective vegetation and numerous exotic and invasive species.

Five farmsteads to implicate the residents in conservation were visited and we dedicated to the consultation with the population and capacitating several working days.
