



Semnopithecus ajax

Known as Wāndur in kashmiri is a leafeating, very shy langur found in the Himalayan regions.

It is the biggest among all the known Indian primates.

Two Himalayan variants of gray landing are known to primatologies.

Semnopithecus schistaceus and Semnopithecusajax.

The two differ morphologically in body coloration. S. schistaceus has pale limbs while as S. ajax has darker limbs.

Initially known to occur only in Kistawar (JK) and Chamba (HP), is now known to be distributed throughout the mountainous regions of the valley. Its habitat are temperate deciduous and coniferous forests of Kashmir.

Wardur is an endangered primate. Possible treats to its population are habitat loss, forest fragmentation & deforestration.
