

Project Update: April 2016

The awareness education among the school going children and local community of the catchment area is completed as per the schedule of time line of my project. Powerpoint presentation on ecological role played by frog was presented among the participants of more than 500 heads from different location at different timing. Field visit along with my supporting survey team was also made among those isolated villages for the same purpose of awareness creation among those houses who could not attend the gathering. I also got opportunity to pass the awareness message among those migratory yak herders who move down to FMU area along with yaks during winter months. Logger were also similarly informed, and infact same message would continue among those resident of catchment area of Gidakom FMU.



Preliminary site visit for efficient survey is completed. The feasible areas for data collection is already well demarcated on the ground and GPS recording is done from forested area and farm land. In total more than 45 plots from stream, rivulets, marshy area and farm land are recorded from different location ranging from 2150 to 3500 m asl with different forest type.
