

Project Update: October 2016

According to our research during the spring, we have made a short summary about the important reedbeds. The generated information from the survey is going to be translated into Albanian by the members of the Albanian Society for Protection of Birds & Mammals.

Small Prespa Lake

The major part of the small Prespa Lake belongs to Greece. The Albanian side is 4 km long and around 1 km wide reedbed area. The Greek side has been a protected area since 2000, and also belongs to a national park. The reedbed is in a good shape, mostly closed with infrequent open water patches. The edge zones of the coastal parts are mostly covered by *Typha angustifolia* and *Schoenoplectus lacustris*. Along the shore the *Iris pseudacorus* is really common too. *Nymphaea alba* is present in the open water. In some parts of the reed bed, marks of cutting and burning activites can be seen, but it does not cover a big area and it does not affect the habitat and the wildlife heavily.

The fishing activity of the locals is mainly based on traditional roots; nevertheless the underwater fish traps and fisher nets can endanger the population of the *Emys orbicularis*. Hunting is a strictly prohibited activity in Albania by the law, but we have noticed the presence of it in several parts. Around the small Prespa Lake we found some recently built hunter hideouts and a lots of shotgun cartridges. Presumably the hunting activity is not significant.

Near the reedbed just a few places are suitable for agricultural using, but those little plots are usually cultivated with horses.
