

Project Update: June 2016

In terms of work done, wildflower season in Palestine is finished until January 2017 so we will pause transplanting until that time. This season we transplanted wild *Ophrys lutea* that were salvaged from an abandoned lot in Ramallah city, as well as pyramidal and trident orchids. We created several of the planters and have continued trail work, neither of which are completed. We also did a workshop on wildflower photography that simultaneously taught about wildflowers, as well as wildflower awareness on social media and a grafting workshop. We will continue workshops in the coming wildflower season and finish the project with the photography exhibition.
