Project Update: June 2016

We finished the sampling the fishes in Krong No River in dry season (February to March 2016). We surveyed and also measured condition of water (pH, DO and temperature) in three different habitats of fish consisting of pool, running water and riffle currents by Hanna HI 98129 and Hanna HI9146. Total the fishes we recorded in this time are 9 species (40 specimens collected) of family Cyprinidae (4 species), Nemacheilidae (2 species), Balitoridae (1 species), Gyrinocheiridae (1 species) and Channidae (1 species). Most of them are cyprinid with high diversity of mophology. Species of Cyprinidae and Channidae are recorded occurring in some small stream and deep pool. Nemacheilidae and Balitoridae are recorded in running water. We did not record any introduced species in this survey. Now, we are planning for analysing morphology and molecule of these fishes to identify them. In July to September 2016, we will conduct the sampling for wet season.
