


Project Update: November 2016




Presentation at Faculty of Science, University of Novi Sad

Students of elementary school "Ivo Andrić" from Banja Luka, visited the Faculty of Science University of Banja Luka in September. During the visit the students were introduced to the

different study programs. Within acquainted with SP Biology and SP Ecology and Environmental Protection we held a presentation and workshop about striped pisor.

We showed them a live specimens and acquainted with basic morphological characteristics, too. Interactive participation of fourth grade students showed great interest in this and similar topics. Introducing students to the importance of the protection of endemic species and its habitat was very productive, as confirmed by the fact that education on this and similar issues must begin from the youngest age.
