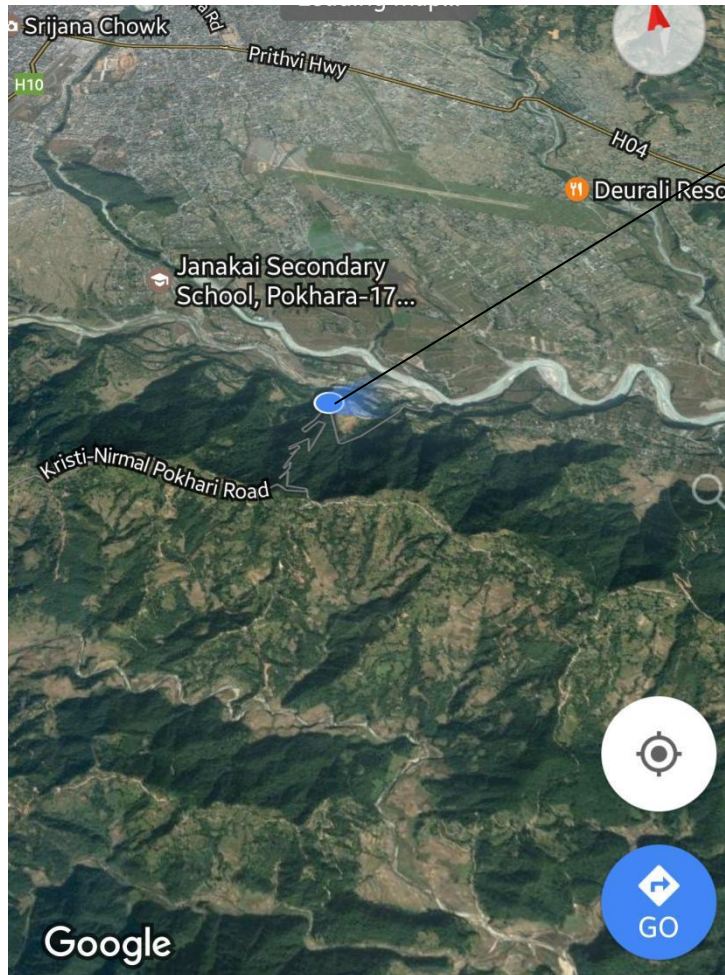


## Project Update: May 2017

I am very glad to inform all vulture lovers and supporters that we are able to record the nest of slender billed vulture at Nirmal Pokhari, Kaski (28.16133, 84.00100, elevation 740m) April 21, 2017. This is one of our major objectives of the project. The nest was built by SBV on a Simal/cotton tree (*Bombax ceiba*).

Human Settlement: Around 100 m away from the nest. River flows around 50 m north of nesting tree.  
Highway/ black topped road less than 20 m away from nest.  
Farming land close (>30m)



Together with Bird conservation Nepal team we recorded altogether 35 number of total 5 different species of vultures, Red-headed (Adult and Sub-adult)-3, Himalayan griffon-12, White rumped vulture-4, Egyptian vulture (adult and Sub adult)-12, Slender billed vulture (Adult, sub-adult and Juvenile)-4.
