

Project Update: March 2017

During November and December 2016 and January 2017 we had we had lots of activities with great results.

Activities included the following:

- Workshops for students, pupils of primary and secondary schools. Workshops are held at one school, Intermediate School 5 and 9 primary. In total, workshops were held for around 1500 pupils and students. Students from elementary and intermediate school were given promotional material in the form of posters with photos and description of the studied species.
- In cooperation with NGO "Association of Parents of Montenegro", held a series workshops attended by parents with their children. Workshops were conducted for about 150 families (children and parents).
- Completed the field work on the River Cijevna, in which the listed species that live with moss *Fissidens fontanus* with the aim of better informing the ecology of this species.
- For the major national scientific event "Open days of science 2016" project was presented and the general public are informed about the importance of moss and possibilities of protection.
- We had a presentations on four television programmes, as well as three national magazines, in order to the general public of Montenegro, informed about the threat and the importance of moss.
