Project Update: March 2017

We explored and sampled in seven caves located in four limestone hills in Sukau area and located seven sinkholes. Caves on Pangi hill are well protected since they are located in a forest reserve with permanent wildlife wardens. However, signs of lodging are present on other hills with no wardens. There are several quarries in this area, of which one is located in a forest reserve (Materes hill) but we didn't find any caves in this hill.

We gave lectures and organised workshops for Community Learning Centre students in Sukau, local community and primary school in Batu Putih, DGFC, KOPEL, and museum staff of Batu Tulug. Leaflets and posters were distributed among local community in Sukau and Batu Putih. We are also planning to give a lecture at Universiti Malaysia Sabah by the end of this month.
