

Project Update: September 2016

During the summer and autumn we have completed our planned field work for 2016. We collected significant amounts of data that will be processed in following months. All animals were marked with the tattooing technique that showed itself successful because we noted significant number of healthy recaptured animals.

We presented our work to the local and regional officials in Bela Crkva, South Banat and they have shown interest in our work and future results. In cooperation with local NGO „School plus“ and elementary school „Dositej Obradović“ from Bela Crkva we managed to organise two promotional lectures for school children and their teachers about the importance of frogs for ecosystems and their threatening factors.
