

Project Update: May 2017

The awareness of the role of conserving black necked crane is raised amongst farmers of Bumthang Dzongkhag through educational programmes. The programme was conducted in three of four Gewogs in the Dzongkhag where black necked crane presence was reported.

The awareness programme on conservation of black necked crane was conducted in Tang Middle Secondary School. The awareness on status, distribution and ecological significance of black necked crane has been shared with participating students and teachers.

The questionnaires were designed and data were collected from few villages under Chumey Gewog. The data includes information on conservation threats, people's perception on conservation of black necked crane and habitat area and assessments. The same survey will also be carried out in the remaining villages under Bumthang Dzongkhag.
