Project Update: May 2016

First field visit

From 16th March to 3rd April 2016 the first field visit was performed in the city of Leticia, the village of Pedrera and the Yaigojé Apaporis National Park. In the city of Leticia was achieved interviewing the professors from the Nacional University Carlos Franky and Juan Alvaro Echeverri and the area chief from Yaigojé Apaporis National Park Diego Luis Muñoz. Likewise, we interviewed Jaime Tanimuca who was Secretary of Education in ACIYA (Asociación de Capitanes Indígenas del Yaigojé Apaporis) in the village of Pedrera. Finally we managed to work with the communities of Centro providencia and Bellavista, where it was possible to hold interviews and a workshop with focus groups formed by shamans, captains, leaders, researchers and women.

With interviews and workshops conducted are expected to synthesize the information gathered to be putting together what will be the results and discussions of the project.
