

Project Update: August 2009

The mangroves have developed well in the restoration area (Cam Thinh Dong, Cam Ranh, Khanh Hoa).

In area 2, the height of the six-month-old mangroves ranges from 43 to 55.30 cm with an average of 48.26 ± 3.45 cm, the diameter of the mangrove's ranges from 1.25 to 1.67 cm with an average of $1.48 \text{ cm} \pm 0.11\text{cm}$. All mangroves have 6 leaves and about 20% of mangroves have 2-4 branches.

In area 3, the height of the eight-month-old mangroves ranges from 47.5 to 65.50 cm with an average of 55.65 ± 4.78 cm, the diameter of the mangrove's ranges from 1.22 to 1.63 cm with an average of 1.50 ± 0.11 cm. All the mangroves have 8-12 leaves and 80% of mangroves have 2-4 branches.

In area 4, the height of the eight-month-old mangroves ranges from 25.00 to 61.00 cm with an average of 38.31 ± 8.33 cm, the diameter of the mangrove's ranges from 1.04 – 1.79 cm with an average of $1.42 \pm 0.21\text{cm}$. All the mangroves in this area have 8-12 leaves and 20% have branches.
