

Project Update: June 2009

After three attempts at replanting mangroves, the survival of the four-month-old mangroves replanted in area 2 (Cam Think Dong, Cam Ranh, Khanh Hoa) is about 30 % (Photo 1 in the attached file).

In area 3 (Cam Think Dong, Cam Ranh, Khanh Hoa), the survival of the four-month-old mangroves was about 80% (Photo 2 in the attached file). The survival of the six-month-old mangroves was about 50% (Photos 3-7 in the attached file). The height of the six-month-old mangroves ranges from 27 to 65 cm with an average of 45.58 ± 8.59 cm, the diameter of the mangrove's ranges from 1.01 to 1.80 cm with an average of 1.35 ± 0.17 cm. All the mangroves have 6-8 leaves, and some mangroves have branches.

In area 4 (Cam Think Dong, Cam Ranh, Khanh Hoa), the survival of the six-month-old mangroves is about 30%. The height of the six-month-old mangroves ranges from 22.5 to 38.2 cm with an average of 29.74 ± 4.80 cm, the diameter of the mangrove's ranges from 1.13 – 1.55 cm with an average of 1.39 ± 0.11 cm. All the mangroves in this area have 6-8 leaves (Photos 8-9 in the attached file).
