

Project Update: July 2003

In July 2003, Ezekial and the Kimboza Project team were awarded a 2 RSG grant to carry on with their work. The Kimboza Project will continue to provide environmental education, promotion of youth conservation clubs in village schools and continue with community reforestation programmes. The project is working to establish honey harvesting as an alternative but significant source of income to villagers with minimal ecological impact.

Team members work with bee keeping extension officers in disseminating knowledge about bee keeping to the villagers. The project will continue to encourage local people at forest edges to take control of resources management and responsibility of safe guarding the forest reserve.
