Project Update: May 2010

The project team is pleased to report that more invasive alien plant species such as pine trees have been removed from all infested areas of Nyika National Park. The clearing of the remaining invasive alien plants was done from 4th-14th May 2010. Further, about 15,000 indigenous plant species have been planted in areas cleared areas of the park. This exercise will help rehabilitate and restore all areas of the park that were infested by invasive alien plants. It is strongly believed that the restoration of the degraded areas will help bring back the population of unique species of wildlife that ran away to other remote areas of the park due to infestation of their natural habitats by the invasive alien plant species.
