Project Update: February 2010

In February 2010, six public lectures were given in the project area. Four lectures were given to eight primary and two community day secondary schools pupils and three lectures to local communities in two villages the project area. In addition, 1500 villagers, including traditional leaders, were educated through drama and traditional dances on the importance of nature and taking an active role in nature conservation.

One of the remarkable achievements of the implementation of project activities is that seven wildlife clubs have been formed in seven schools visited and traditional leaders in the two villages educated about the project have expressed their full support towards the implementation of the project. The project team was told that the chiefs will be working with their subjects to convince them to find another land for cultivation and settlement so that they should be living in harmony with wildlife.
