Project Update: October 2010

From September to October 2010, the project team mobilised communities bordering the project site. The aim of the mobilisation meetings were to lobby community members to take active part in filling up of pit traps that were dug by community farmers to trap wildlife species that were destroying their agricultural crops and livestock. By the end of October 2010, eleven pit traps were successfully filled up and about 20 ha of disturbed land has been tilled by communities in order to be reforestated during this coming rainy season. Some of the remarkable achievements include: - communities were mobilised, supported our efforts and actively participated in the land fill programme, and rehabilitation of disturbed wildlife corridor.
