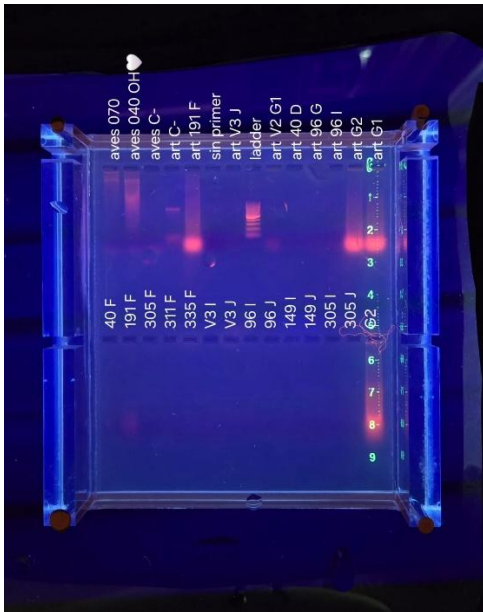
- We began genetic analysis of bat droppings in the laboratory:





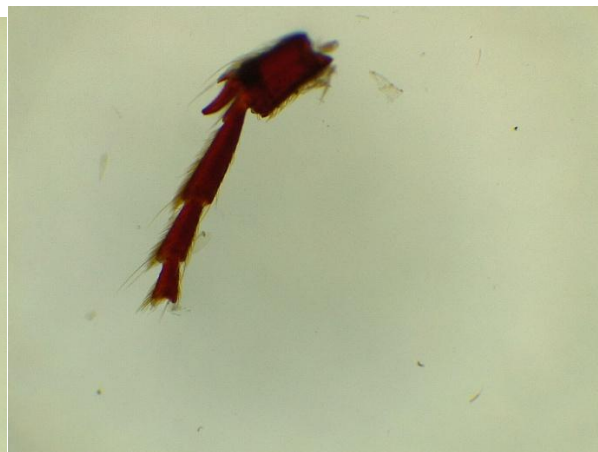
