Project Update: April 2018

At the start of the new field season, late March and early April, Miloš Popović and I visited biology and ecology students from Universities of Niš, Belgrade and Novi Sad.

Our lectures included two segments: first on distribution of *Emys orbicularis*, and other reptile species in Serbia; and second part which introduced Biologer web site (https://biologer.org/) and android application for gathering distribution data. The lectures reached more than 150 interested naturalists. Educational leaflets were prepared and printed for the occasion (electronic version is available with this update). We had a good feedback during presentations and we are looking forward to include more people in development of Biologer database.
