Project Update: February 2018

Website (https://www.biologer.org) and mobile phone application for gathering distribution data are in their final preparation stages. The solid ground behind the Biologer database has been set; it is at the operational state and tested. During the field season it will be further tested and potential bugs found in the source code will be fixed. At the moment amphibians and reptiles of Serbia are listed, while the butterfly species are next to be added.

We presented the project ideas and results at several scientific conferences. The new website and mobile phone application were presented on two occasions: at 11th Symposium of Serbian Entomogists, by Miloš Popović (September 2017); and at 27th Rufford Small Grant Conference, "From mountains to deep seas", by Ana Golubović (February 2018). Preliminary results on sexual dimorphism and population characteristics of European pond turtle in Serbia were presented at 19th European Congress of Herpetology, by Ana Golubović (September 2017).
