Project Update: July 2017

I participated and presented a poster at the 3rd Island Invasives Conference, held from 10th - 14th July 2017 at the University of Dundee, UK. The study described in the poster explores how the local community's knowledge on invasive species can be used as a cost-effective survey technique. This is an outcome of rigorous field work undertaken for the Indian bullfrog project.
