

Project Update: December 2017

From September to November 2017, Geraud C. Tasse, project leader travelled to villages in the Moungo division and successfully administered over 113 questionnaires. Ecological survey was also carried out around Mangamba village where frog sightings were documented.



Geraud attended the Cameroon Bioscience Conference in Buea from November 30th to December 2nd 2017. During this conference, He presented a poster describing preliminary results from modelling goliath frog ecological niche and socioeconomic survey conducted so far. He briefed the audience on the threats this frog is facing and showed that number of locals living in the area have a good perception toward the conservation of this frog provided they are given alternative income generating activities.
