Project Update: January 2017

Another good note for you is that we are now collaborating with an environmental organisation out of Cawsand UK on marine micro plastic remediation. The plan is to run static charge filtration of beaches on the Rame Peninsula. The SW coast of England is buried under a massive amount of marine plastic, including an extremely high density of marine micro plastic. I am not sure you know about that branch of our operations but I have invented and patented a revolutionary system for filtering marine micro plastic out of the beach. There is some information on our website plastic pages and a good film that shows how our operations work -- "Filtering a Plastic Ocean". I am very excited to be collaborating with this group on the Rame Peninsula, you have done so much for our organisation and now I feel that I actually have the opportunity to make a significant positive impact for the UK. You should see that film; there is a link on our website.

The static charge filtration system is a movement that is catching on globally and makes it possible to finally remove large amounts of micro plastic from the marine system. Micro plastic kills hundreds of marine turtles every year.

We have also had a request from a group in Wales to purchase Static Charge Filtration (SCF) screens. I am hoping that we can soon be responsible for getting filtrations operations going on the entire SW England coast.

We are looking for a sponsor to cover manufacturing cost of the SCF screens so we can just start shipping them out for free. We started this division of STF -- called the STF/Blue Wave - with a zero budget, so we had very few funds to work with and have to charge each organisation for manufacturing and shipping cost. We do get a 75% discount on international shipping but the SCF screen cost has been slowing the expansion of our movement.
