

Project Update: April 2018

Fieldtrip in Nevesinjsko polje, Bosnia and Herzegovina (Fig. 1) was carried out in February 2018. Because of the large amount of precipitation and inaccessibility of the locality, the fieldtrip which had been planned to be carried out in Autumn 2017 was postponed to the beginning of 2018.

25 fishes from Nevesinjsko Polje were sampled (Fig. 2). Each individual was taken a photo for morphometric analysis and a part of the dorsal fin for DNA analysis. We transported samples to the Laboratory of Evolutionary Biology at the Faculty of Sciences, University of Novi Sad. According to the standard methodology we carried out an experimental part of the molecular analysis and geometric morphometry. Analysis and processing of results are in progress. The results will be published in a scientific journal.
