Project Update: December 2017

In the 3rd update of our project, we have three activities that were held in November and December 2017.

On November 6th-7th 2017, we held the "Basic Molecular Training on DNA Forensic of Sea Turtle" workshop in Madura, East Java, in collaboration with the Marine Science Department, Faculty of Agriculture, Trunojoyo University. 27 people participated in this workshop including students, lecturers and laboratory technicians.
