Project Update: March 2018

After completing the first phase of the project we had planned to conduct a survey on forest and agricultural land farms to capture tree dwelling bats which weren't identified previously. However, winter just got started soon after completing the first phase of the field visit. Cave dwelling bats seemed to be congregating in the caves as their hibernation period was in progress. Tree dwelling bats' foraging activities during winter season were also observed to be lower than the previous months. As bats' foraging activities reduced the chance of their capture in mist nets and harp traps this automatically reduces our ability to accomplish our project objectives. Hence, to manage the time, resources and effort to attain project goal, the surveys along the forest landscape and agricultural land farms were postponed. During these 4 months of winter period from November 2017 to February 2018 several conservation activities were performed. We designed and printed the conservation posters, attended RSG Nepal conference 2018, presented poster presentation in Nepal owl Festival 2018 and published news as well as blog post of our activities in national newspaper and webpage of Nepal Bat Research and Conservation (NeBRCU) respectively.

Activities Performed

- ➤ One oral presentation on "Pre Project Discussion of Bats Survey and Conservation Outreach Program along Kaligandaki Canyon" was delivered during the training ceremony of "Unleashing Young Minds for Wildlife Conservation" organised by Forest for Transformation (FFT Nepal) on 4th August 2017.
- ➤ One news article entitle as "Dhaulagirika Guphama 13 Prajatika Chamera" (in Nepali) was posted in "Nagarik Dainik" A national newspaper, on 3rd November 2017 by a journalist Harikrishna Gautam. The news was again shared and disseminated through "Beni online Khabar" a local news and media website which has nearly 46,000 followers on facebook page.
- ➤ One blog post entitle, "Bats survey at Kaligandaki Canyon" was posted on 2nd November 2017 in webpage of NeBRCU highlighting major findings of first phase of field work.
- Conservation poster carrying key messages for bats conservation was designed and 1000 copies were printed during the period of December and distributed among the participants of RSG conference Nepal 2018, locals visiting Nepal owl festival 2018 and students from Institute of Forestry, Pokhara, Nepal.
- ➤ Poster presentation of our ongoing project was presented during the RSG Nepal conference 2018 held in Kathmandu Nepal on 30th and 31st January 2018. Project's major findings and updates were shared among renowned wildlife researchers and conservationists of Nepal, young researchers and students from several fields as well as policy makers.
- ➤ Additionally, poster was again presented during "Nepal Owl Festivals 2018" a two days festival annually organized by Friends of Nature (FON Nepal) that mainly focused on conservation of owls as well as other wildlife species on 2nd and 3rd of February 2018 held in Jiri, Dolakha, Nepal.

Bats Survey at Kaligandaki Canyon

NeBRCU is now officially carrying out bats survey along Kaligandaki canyon from Kushma of Parbat district to Jomsom of Mustang. Me and my colleague Mr. Anoj Subedi from Institute of Forestry (IOF), Pokhara were sent off for preliminary assessment of the survey. After 10 days of hard work and endurance we have managed to discover some habitats for cave dwelling bats. Out of 16 discovered caves, only 11 were identified as suitable for bat roost whereas
