Project Update: May 2018

In April and May 2018we continued with field research and other project activities.

Valuable data from the northern alluvial territories and lowlands have been collected and recorded. Drina River near city of Bijeljina was investigated together with quite intriguing ecosystems and wetlands in some other localities in Semberija.

Preliminary data from this part of Bosnia and Herzegovina have been inputted into Mycological Society MycoBH electronic database.

Apart from northern territories a couple of field trips have been organised in central and northwest parts of the country (Nišići, Igman, Bjelašnica, river Orlja – Olovo and Lisina Mt. near Mrkonjić Grad).

Some quite rare and endangered species of fungi have been registered, photographed and determined.

We have continue with preparation of the manuscript and new scientific article about some species of Pezizales that have been registered during project activities.

We have also continue with filming scenes for documentary movie about ascomycetous fungi with Public Broadcasting service of Bosnia and Herzegovina (BHRT) as a production company.
