

Project Update: July 2018

Along with the accompaniment of the group, "Almandros collective for a better world" the monitoring of the survival and growth of native medicinal tree species was carried out, for an annual cycle, in two experimental plots of the La Cumbre and Tomás Garrido Canabal communities, Tacotalpa, Tabasco, Mexico. The environmental factors associated with growth (light, soil and association of species) have been monitored. The data resulting from the monitoring is being analyzed to observe the relationship of growth - survival with environmental factors. The elaboration of the dissemination manual of the ethnobotanical process of the project continues. An article is being developed for publication in a highly recognized international journal. Continuity to the social processes that have been consolidated in the Almandros collective, as part of the development of the project is also taking place.
