

Project Update: April 2019

The fourth phase of the project took place from October 2018 to February 2019. The main task was to administer household questionnaire, key informants and participatory rural appraisal (PRA). Key issues captured was on the preferred grazing areas, most preferred species, traditional grazing routes, available conservation measures of overgrazed land and indigenous criteria used by local pastoralists for the selection of grazing area. This activity was done with the aid of community (Maasai).
