2-6 June 2008



14-18 June 2008

- Conducting a survey for searching population and breeding colony of Milky stork in Batang river and Kumpai river (the east coastal of Ogan Komering Ilir District). In this survey, breeding colony of Milky stork in Sumatra finally rediscovered. In addition, some waterbird were observed breed in this area.

23-26 June 2008

- Based on information from local people, we also visiting a location in the East coastal of Ogan Komering Ilir namely Simpang Tiga village. Unfortunately, we failed to discover breeding colony. A Milky stork was observed as bird keeping in a home of Simpang Tiga village, but this bird said by the owner bought from Sungai Kuala 12 (not from Simpang Tiga).

1-3 July 2008

14-27 July 2008

- Conducting a survey for searching population and breeding colony of Milky stork in Talang Lubuk.

1-14 August 2008

- Develop a communication and discuss with Dr. Matthias Waltert (Biodiversity Specialist from Goetingen University, Germany) who will work for biodiversity assessment for SFFMP (South Sumatra Forest Fire Management Project/EU-GTZ-Government of South Sumatra Province) in the Merang Peatdome forest in Musi Banyuasin District South

Sumatra. This area is important for buffer and bridge for large mammal (Tiger, Tapir, elephant and etc) between Berbak and Sembilang National Park in the Jambi and South Sumatra Province.

15-30 August 2008

- Assisting Dr. Matthias Waltert for conducting biodiversity research in Merang Peatdome forest. The applicant use this chance for learning his methods and conducting a survey for searching population and breeding colony of Milky stork in the area.
