

Project Update: December 2010

This field survey in the Gobustan National Park was conducted in order to collect qualitative and quantitative data and information on actual rare vegetation classes to be use for supervised classification analysis. Test sites were selected and evaluated both by remote sensing techniques and field investigations.

As the result of this field season, we sufficiently enlarged our data and information on the rare vegetation distribution in Gobustan. Sampling was conducted in the sensitive area of the Gobustan National Park, where we registered new localities of the vegetation. The latitude and longitudes were recorded for each plot using GPS.
