

Project Update: January 2019

We have spent a lot of time in the field, trying to collect as much information about wolf's presence and activities in different localities as it is possible.

We observed the presence of wolf individuals at several monitored localities (Fig. 1) and in only one location the presence of the whole pack (according to the tracks in the snow), (Fig. 2). Finally, we observed the presence of a few individuals at the Čemernica locality (Fig. 3). Also, we observed some concerning photos about the presence of the wolf with the bad health condition and strange behaviour (Fig. 4).
