

Project Update: October 2018

Visual and auditory censuses were carried out, using lineal transects of 1 km separated by 500 m each, during the dry season in each of the proposed sites in the Austral Yungas of Argentina.

In each transect the species of turkey was determined, georeferencing the species, in addition the number of individuals or groups, the time and the perpendicular distance from the observer to the observed species was determined.

Data of the topography and structure of the vegetation were taken.

All activities included volunteers from the Universidad Nacional de Jujuy and was accompanied by park rangers from each site.
