Project Update: January 2020

I would like to share with you the results of the second round Harvesting period, as this project was aimed to grow non palatable crops for baboons ,we included the section of seeing crops that adapt and give products to help the local community. We found that carrots are eaten by baboons but have a good productivity while beetroots are not eaten by baboons and very productive on this type of soil but we will still grow them together with amalanthus and spinach to keep fighting against malnutrition for the local people where we will teach them how to cook beetroots together with other food.

On 17th February 2020, there will be a section of cooking together with 40 families selected at Kitabi sector who have kids live below the line of good nutrition meaning that are malnurished.
