Project Update: August 2019

To date, three field trips have been made in which the approaches with the community have been carried out, the socialization of the project where the activities to be developed were exposed and finally the traps for establishing native bees nests were elaborated and installed in each of the benefited farms.

The community has had a great acceptance of the project and they are interested in developing agroecological processes where nature benefits, since they are aware that the practices that have been carried out to date have not been the healthiest.

At the same time, the native bees found in the area have been identified, evidencing the presence of the Tetragonisca angustula species, with which we want to start a meliponiculture process that benefits the conservation of pollinators and the community involved.
