Conservation of Threatened Vulture Species Through Research and Awareness Raising Programs in Chitral Pakistan

NSAID Drugs Report:

NSAIDs have caused a catastrophic decline in vulture populations worldwide. Although in most countries of the world NSAID drugs are legally banned, they are still manufactured and continue to be in use in many countries thus posing a threat to the survival of the species. To investigate the availability and use of NSAID drugs a survey was conducted in the veterinary hospitals and shops in the project sites in Chitral.

A total of 16 veterinary facilities, including government hospitals and private shops, were surveyed during the study, which included five public veterinary hospitals and 11 privately owned shops in different areas of Chitral (Table. 1). The study found that NSAID drugs are sold in different veterinary hospitals and veterinary medical stores. Although Meloxicam was also available at different stores and being prescribe by the veterinarians seven NSAID drugs were found to be in use and available in all the veterinary hospitals and veterinary medical stores in lower Chitral.

The following drugs were found in different veterinary shops/ hospitals during the survey: Flunixin meglumine, Diclofenac Sodium, Butadin, Phenylbutazone, Mefenamic Acid, and Analgen. Details of the drugs, manufacturer can be found in Table 2. Along with the drugs of veterinary use it was reported by the shopkeepers and veterinarians that other drugs of human use such as Analgin, Mefenamic acid, Vorin, etc. are also prescribed for livestock with high doses in the absence of specific veterinary drugs.

The veterinarians and shopkeepers had no knowledge regarding NSAIDs and their effect on vultures and whether selling of NSAID is legally banned or not. Most of the shopkeepers had no relevant qualification and were not aware about the uses of the drugs. All the veterinarians said that diclofenac drugs are used as painkiller, nine of them also prescribed diclofenac Sodium to reduce temperature, while five also prescribed the drug for inflammation. One of the veterinarians reported that the drug is

used as a de-wormer and as antibiotic whereas two of them prescribed the drug for muscle relaxation and infection.

The results of the survey showed that that NSAID drugs such as Diclofenac Sodium, Phenylbutazone and others are available in different veterinary hospitals and veterinary medical stores and are used to treat livestock in the study area. Veterinarians in hospitals and veterinary medical stores have no knowledge about the side effects of NSAID drugs. All the veterinarians did not know what vultures are and what caused their population declines. They considered Diclofenac drug as a safe drug. They usually prescribe any type of Diclofenac drugs to treat animals. The veterinarians had no information about ban on some of the NASID drugs. It is important to note that all the NSAID drugs available in local markets are manufactured in big cities of Pakistan such as Lahore, Islamabad, Karachi, Peshawar, etc., reflecting that the same are also supplied to other parts of Pakistan and thus continue to be a threat for vultures. Interestingly, one of the NSAID drugs (Diclocin Forte, tablet) is manufactured in India and the study area is far away from the Pakistan-India border. One possible route may be via Afghanistan. It shows that production/ manufacturing NSAID drugs have consequences beyond international borders.

The project has now reached to the veterinarians with awareness raising materials to educate them about the consequences of NSAID drugs for vultures and telling them what the safe alternatives of diclofenac sodium are available. It is suggested to reach out to the manufacturer pharma's of the drugs and strict implementation of the ban.
