Project Update: May 2021

In April and May 2021, the third round of data collection activities were continued in Banda within five villages and neighborhood community to collect information on factors that prevent adults using contraceptive methods and its impact on conservation of Nyungwe park.

The main activities carried out were project activities awareness and mobilisation, filling out questionnaires to collect data. Though mass campaigns were limited to certain number due to COVID-19 pandemic, the team used village to village within target cells, and door to door for awareness and mobilization; thereafter we brought together closed number from respective households

After understanding research aim, interested people has consented to participate in data collection through volunteer's guide. Below are detailed about some activities completed.
