

Project Update: August 2020

Given the whole situation with the Covid-19 virus pandemic, we tried to respect all safety measures during the entire field research. We worked on Lake Markovačko all last week, in accordance with the project plan. On Monday, we set up the fyke nets and took them out, emptied them and put them back in the water until Friday. We managed to catch 5725 black bullhead specimens with a total weight of 139,590 g. In order to avoid work in the laboratory, we performed measurements and dissections on the shores of the lake.

In addition to colleagues from the Institute for Multidisciplinary Research and the Faculty of Biology, we were accompanied by two students of ecology and environmental protection from the Faculty of Biology University of Belgrade, as well as one student of Ecology and Environmental Protection from the private faculty "Singidunum" from Belgrade.

Also, for one day, we were accompanied by Petar Srok, who has his own independent production and makes shows for the television "Hunting and Fishing", which is broadcast on cable television. He will make a show about our project.

Experimental breeding at CEFAH is also being carried out according to plan.
