

Project Update: September 2020

We have managed to construct beehive fences with 50 hives in each village (Kisemo, Mgude and Kisaki Kituoni) between 23-30 August 2020.

- five hives are occupied by bees in Kisemo village.
- 10 hives are occupied by bees in Mgude village.
- seven hives are occupied by bees in Kisaki Kituoni village.

Elephants have been reported to be scared with the fence areas and have changed their routes to avoid farm areas.

We have facilitated the formation and registration of Village Saving and Loans Association in three villages (Kisemo, Mgude and Kisaki kituoni). The VSLA's operations started on 5 September 2020 in all three villages.

- Kisemo VSLA has 31 members (\$150 shares and \$100 social fund).
- Mgude VSLA has 35 members (\$180 shares and \$120 social fund).
- Kisaki VSLA has 27 members (\$200 shares and \$125 social fund).

The loan cycle will start on 5 December 2020 in all villages.
