### **BARDAČA „MEET UP“**

**"Bardača MEET UP"(BMU)** event was organized by the U.G. C.E.Z.A.R. on the 5th July, internationally celebrating as the World Environment Day. The event was organized within the frame of the [BH Green Network](#), supported by the Italian Embassy in Bosnia and Herzegovina ([Embassy of Italy in Bosnia and Herzegovina](#)).

The main idea of the **BMU** was to signify the importance of preservation of Bardača Ramsar Area (<https://rsis.ramsar.org/ris/1658>), devastated by humans. **BMU** gathered around 60 participants from several NGOs from all over Bosnia and Herzegovina. The special guests were Mrs. Mirjona Sadiku, representing the Italian Developing Agency, and Ms. Ferdinand Koenig, a delegate of the Europe Union in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

In the first part of the event, participants presented their activities in the protection of the Environment across Bosnia and Herzegovina. As this area is a natural habitat of Wildcats, we presented our project to all participants as we aim to extend the territory of the wildcat monitoring to this area also in the future project steps and we discussed with mrs Mirjona Sadiku about the potential collaboration as well. The last activity of the event was "ECO Walk" where we showed to the participants devastated lakes of Bardača, and areas possibly inhabited by wildcats.
